NOTIFICATION

No.T-5(1)/2013-GBC. Gilgit-Baltistan Council Secretariat, Islamabad has approved to continue following existing royalty rates for the calendar year 2015:-

- i. Zero royalty fee for peak upto 6500-M
- ii. 10% royalty fee on mountains situated in Gilgit, and Ghizer except on Spantik/Golden Peak.
- iii. 05% royalty fee on all peaks during winter season (December-February)
- iv. 40% Discount on royalty fee on all peaks except as mentioned in (i) & (ii) above as detailed below:-
