Gilgit-Baltistan Council is a constitutional body established in 2010 under Article 33 of Gilgit-Baltistan (Empowerment and Self Governance) Order, 2009. The Council has clearly defined executive and legislative powers. The Council has following composition.

C. Six members nominated by the Prime Minister of Pakistan from amongst Federal Ministers/Members of the Parliament

D The Federal Minister for Kashmir Affairs and Gilgit-Baltistan is an *ex officio* Member and Minister-in-charge of the Council.

E. The Chief Minister of Gilgit-Baltistan

F. Six members elected by the GB Assembly in accordance with the system of proportional representation by means of a single transferable vote

G. The Minister of State for Kashmir Affairs and Gilgit- Baltistan is *ex officio* non voting member of the Council
